Flex was launched in 2015, and now operates in about 50 U.S. cities. Anyone over

21 with a driver's license, auto insurance and at least a midsize sedan can
sign up. After clearing a basic background check, drivers in areas with open sp

ots can start picking up and delivering packages.

CNBC spent a day delivering with Flex driver Omar Montes in the San Francisco Ba
y Area, where he helped a friend deliver around 46 packages in 3½ hours, fo

r \$105.
